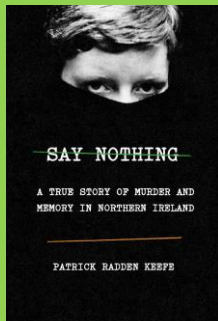

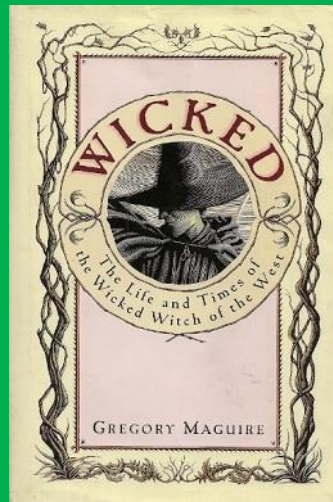
**Pick of the Month Non-Fiction**
